

PENN HILLS LEAF AND YARD WASTE COMPOSTING PROGRAM

Acceptable material:

- Leaves,
- Garden Residue
- Shrubbery and Tree Trimmings less than ½ inch in diameter

Unacceptable material:

- No Grass
- No Dirt, Stones or Roots
- No Tape or Plastic Bags
- No Other Paper Bags, Boxes or Other Containers
- Please Do Not Rake Leaves to the Curb (Ordinance #2012-2548)

Scheduled Collection dates are:

Monday, April 11th, Monday, April 18th and Monday, April 25th.

NO SPRING LEAF COLLECTION WILL BE MADE WITHOUT A SCHEDULED PICK UP.

Please CALL 412-798-2151 at least 24 HOURS in advance to schedule a pick up.

Bags MUST be placed at the curb the evening before the scheduled pick up.

The above acceptable items can also be dropped off at the compost site throughout the year by making an appointment with Public Works (412-798-2151).

A minimum of 24 hours notice is needed to schedule an appointment.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. We encourage you to purchase approved paper leaf bags at any of the following local businesses:
Community Market – 1107 Milltown Road
Eastwood Hardware - Penn Hills Shopping Center
Giant Eagle - Penn Hills Shopping Center, Rodi Road
Giant Eagle – 9001 Frankstown Road
Penn Hills Lawn and Garden Center - 200 Jefferson Road
R. F. Jackson and Sons Hardware – 3364 Universal Road
Verona Giant Eagle – 200 Allegheny River Boulevard
Home Depot, Lowe's and Walmart also have the acceptable paper leaf bags available for purchase.
2. Leaf/yard waste must be placed in approved paper leaf bags and placed at the curb on the above special dates. **Any leaf/yard waste not in approved bags will not be picked up.**
3. Fold the top of the leaf bag to avoid spilling leaves.
(PLEASE DO NOT USE STAPLES OR TAPE TO CLOSE THE BAG.)
4. Leaf bags cannot weigh more than 30 lbs. Bags that are too heavy to lift or filled with inappropriate material will be left behind.
5. Place the leaf bags out for collection after requesting a pick-up in accordance with the schedule above.
