A NEW SERVICE FOR PENN HILLS RESIDENTS

E-WASTE COLLECTION

Dear Penn Hills Residents,

Republic Services continues to be the Municipality of Penn Hills' exclusive trash and recyclables hauler and will be your E-Waste hauler beginning January 1, 2016. Your trash collection will continue as before, with all trash being placed at the curb no later than 6 a.m. on your regular collection day.

Republic Services, the second largest provider of services in the domestic non-hazardous solid waste industry, is excited to be handling this new service for you.

GUIDELINES FOR TRASH COLLECTION:

Trash should be in properly secured containers up to a 40-gallon capacity and weighing no more than 60 pounds or plastic bags that do not exceed 32 gallons in capacity and not weighing more than 60 pounds. Bulk material (brush, tree or shrub trimmings including Christmas trees, carpeting, etc.) shall be cut in 4-foot lengths and tied in 18-inch bundles, weighing not more than 75 pounds and protected from getting rain soaked. Small shrubs will be picked up in one piece if they are within the specified limitations.

Furniture and/or appliances, or other listed items (mattress/box springs collected together as 1 bulky item) shall be picked up on the regular collection day in one piece. Appliances containing refrigerant such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers, or any other similar appliance MUST have Freon reclaimed by a Certified Technician and have a sticker displayed stating that has been completed before the appliance can be picked up.

Cardboard must be broken down so it is flat and no more than 3 feet in length or width and tied in a bundle.

Empty paint cans and/or dried paint is acceptable. Air dry the paint or soak up any excess paint with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be left off paint cans.

Construction debris will be collected from small general residential repairs and cannot exceed 60 pounds and loose materials must fit into 40-gallon containers with the lid closed.

Examples of general repairs: replacement of toilets, counter tops not exceeding 4 feet in length, and cabinets not exceeding 36 x 36 x 30 inches

COLLECTION SCHEDULE:

Residents are to have their trash at the curb by 6 a.m. on their regular collection day. You may place up to 10 bags or equivalent number of containers and no more than 2 bulky items at the curb on collection days. Special collection is available for a fee for more than 10 bags or an equivalent number of containers or more than 2 bulky items. Please call customer service at 724-887-9400 for pricing and scheduling. Recyclables will continue to be collected every other week on the regular collection day.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:


We will be closed on six major holidays: **NEW YEAR'S DAY, MEMORIAL DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, WEDNESDAY, THANKSGIVING DAY, and CHRISTMAS DAY.** If your trash service falls on or after a holiday, your collection will be delayed by one day that week. Should one of these holidays fall on a Saturday or Sunday, all collections for the following week will be performed on the normal collection day without delay.

ITEMS NOT COLLECTED:

We will not collect asbestos or material containing asbestos, lead acid batteries, automobile parts, infectious or oily hazardous waste, ashes, steel drums, hazardous waste, oil, liquid paint, solvent liquids, medical waste, flammable and toxic waste, tires with rims on, large batteries, rocks, bricks, stone, construction materials, dirt, any items in excess of 75 pounds, appliances containing CFC or Freon, unsecured bundles of material that are unsafe for collection or anything over 4 feet in length, tree limbs more than 3 inches in diameter and more than 4 feet in length.

E-WASTE SERVICE BEGINS APRIL 1, 2016

A New Service to residents in Penn Hills is E-Waste collection offered by Republic Services. There is no additional charge for this service.

E-Waste can now be safely collected from each home by calling **724-887-9400** or emailing us at e-wasteph@republicservices.com. Data destruction is assured.

E-Waste will include: Televisions, Computers, Monitors, VCR and DVD Players, Printers, Fax Machines, Cable Boxes, Keyboards, Gaming Equipment and similar electronic waste. There will be a limit of two Televisions and/or Computer Monitors during each collection.

Residents must call toll-free **724-887-9400** or email us at e-wasteph@republicservices.com to arrange for collection. Residents will then be asked to describe the items they wish to have collected. Residents will be told when and where on their property the E-Waste will be collected.

These E-Waste items will NOT be placed at the curb with the weekly trash.

The collection of E-Waste will be made with a separate truck and crew and may not be on the same day as your regular trash collection.
