### HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL COLLECTIONS

Six events scheduled May - October

**Launch Saturday, May 6,** from 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. at North Park Swimming Pool parking lot, Allegheny County.

Individuals can drop off automotive fluids, household cleaners, pesticides, paints and other household chemicals for a cost of \$3/gallon (a few exceptions apply), cash only.

# HARD-TO-RECYCLE COLLECTIONS

Five events scheduled May - October

**Launch Saturday, May 13,** from 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. at Galleria at Pittsburgh Mills, Frazer Township, Allegheny County.

Individuals can drop off "e-waste" such as computer towers and peripheral equipment, cell phones, printer/toner cartridges, CFLs and expanded polystyrene packaging
