SUBSTANTIAL CHANGE TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

YEAR 41, 42, and 43

On Monday, June 04, 2018, the Mayor and Council of Penn Hills will meet at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers, 12245 Frankstown Road, to consider the following substantial change to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.

Funds from sidewalks and older inactive accounts will be redistributed to fund street reconstruction, demolition and four Public Facilities. The chart below illustrates the redistribution of funds.
