The Penn Hills Zoning Hearing Board will convene its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on Wednesday October 24th, 2018 at 7:00 P.M., in the Penn Hills Government Center, Council Chambers, at 102 Duff Road Pittsburgh PA 15235 to consider the following:

Case # 25 of 2018 REVISION: The Penn Hills School District is requesting a Use Variance to permit the operation of an automotive repair/ storage business at 240 Aster Street, Lot and Block # 537-A-336.

Case # 31: Ronald Makay of 845 4th Street, Lot and Block # 364-H-40, is requesting a Variance for the placement of a fence at a height of six (6) feet where as the property is limited to four (4) feet by ordinance.

Case #32 of 2018: Robin McClendon of 10445 Lindberg Avenue, Lot and Block # 369-E-158, is requesting a Variance to permit the parking of an RV (Recreational Vehicle) within an area prohibited by ordinance in a residential zoning district.

Case #33 of 2018: Tim Lanica of 6601 Verona Road, Lot and Block # 365-H-391, is requesting a Dimensional Variance to permit the construction of a Garage Structure on the property whereas the property is limited by ordinance to have a twenty (20) foot area & five (5) foot area of open space.

**Case #34 of 2018:** Kerry Wagner of 5321 White Oak Drive, Lot and Block # 366-N-189, is requesting a Home Occupation in order to permit the operation of his home business "Wagners Lawn Maintenance"

**Case #35 of 2018:** Maura Williams of 402 Pennwood Drive, Lot and Block # 369-L-361, is requesting a Home Occupation in order to permit the operation of her home business "Happy Hour Desserts by Maura LLC"
