

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Municipality of Penn Hills, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania until 10:30 a.m. on June 20, 2019 to be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter for the following project:

**2019 PENN HILLS CAPITAL ROAD PROGRAM**

**BASE BID**

Approximately 21,000 L.F. of 2", 6' Wide Keyway Milling, 1,650 S.Y. of Soft Spot Repair, 2,475 Tons of Superpave 9.5 mm Leveling Course, 32,500 S.Y. of 1.5" Superpave 9.5mm Wearing Course, 17,450 Lineal Feet of Bituminous Wedge Curb, 600 Lineal Feet of Transverse Keyways, 7 Storm Inlet Replacements, Traffic Control, Resident Notification and Restoration.

**ADD ALTERNATE 1**

Approximately 2,350 L.F. of 2", 6' Wide Keyway Milling, 175 S.Y. of Soft Spot Repair, 280 Tons of Superpave 9.5 mm Leveling Course, 3,460 S.Y. of 1.5" Superpave 9.5mm Wearing Course, 2,350 Lineal Feet of Bituminous Wedge Curb, 50 Lineal Feet of Transverse Keyways, 1 Storm Inlet Replacement, Traffic Control, Resident Notification, and Restoration.

**ADD ALTERNATE 2**

Approximately 2,100 L.F. of 2", 6' Wide Keyway Milling, 135 S.Y. of Soft Spot Repair, 140 Tons of Superpave 9.5 mm Leveling Course, 2,540 S.Y. of 1.5" Superpave 9.5mm Wearing Course, 75 Lineal Feet of Transverse Keyways, Traffic Control, Resident Notification, and Restoration.

**ADD ALTERNATE 3**

Approximately 1,950 L.F. of 2", 6' Wide Keyway Milling, 175 S.Y. of Soft Spot Repair, 250 Tons of Superpave 9.5 mm Leveling Course, 3,300 S.Y. of 1.5" Superpave 9.5mm Wearing Course, 1,950 Lineal Feet of Bituminous Wedge Curb, 100 Lineal Feet of Transverse Keyways, Traffic Control, Resident Notification, and Restoration.

All bidders shall be PennDOT pre-qualified and submit their PennDOT Pre-Qualification Certificates as well as the Anti-Collusion Affidavit with the Proposal in order for the Proposal to be considered responsive.

All Proposals must be in the hands of the Purchasing Department, Municipality of Penn Hills, 102 Duff Road, Penn Hills, PA 15235, by 10:30 a.m. prevailing time, June 20, 2019.

Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the word **"2019 PENN HILLS CAPITAL ROAD PROGRAM."**

Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement are on file and open to public inspection at The Gateway Engineers, Inc. offices, located at 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15205 where sets of said documents may be obtained upon payment of \$50.00 per set. No refund will be made for the return of any documents.

**Pennsylvania Prevailing Wages are required to be paid on this project.**

**There will be a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting on June 12, 2019 at 10:30 a.m. at the Municipality of Penn Hills Public Council Chambers, 102 Duff Road, Penn Hills, PA 15235.**

Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided by the Municipality of Penn Hills. Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of the Municipality of Penn Hills in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within 15 days after Notice of the Award of the Contract.

The Proposals must be made to the Municipality of Penn Hills, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of ninety (90) days. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the ninety (90) day period without forfeiting his Bid guarantee.

Performance, Maintenance, and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement upon acceptance of the Proposal from the successful Bidder.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein.
