

**NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT
MUNICIPALITY OF PENN HILLS, PA
FY 2018 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The purpose of this notice is to present substantial amendments to the Municipality of Penn Hills' FY 2018 Annual Action Plan for the use of Community Development Block Grant funds.

In accordance with CDBG program regulations, the Municipality is allowed to make substantial amendments to its Annual Action Plan and Budget in accordance with the Municipality's Citizen Participation Plan.

Penn Hills has determined that it is necessary to amend the approved CDBG program budget for the previously approved program year FY 2018. This is considered a substantial amendment in accordance with the Municipality's Citizen Participation Plan as the following applies: a) Adding or dropping an activity.

The amendment to the FY 2018 CDBG Annual Action Plan is proposed as follows:

- **Year 44 YMCA Scholarship Program** –delete the activity and reallocate the line item budget amount of \$11,000 to the existing Year 44 activity, William McKinley Improvements.
- **Year 44 William McKinley Improvements** –increase the line item budget amount by \$11,000 for a revised budget amount of \$31,000.

In order to obtain the views of residents, public agencies and other interested parties, Penn Hills has placed the Substantial Amendment on public display beginning Monday, March 11, 2019 at the following location:Municipal Building, 102 Duff Road, Penn Hills, PA 15235.

This document will be available to the public during normal hours of operation for a period of thirty (30) days until Monday, April 15, 2019, after which time the Substantial Amendment will be considered by Council for submittal to HUD for approval.

On Monday, April 15, 2019, the Mayor and Council of Penn Hills will meet at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers Municipal Building, 102 Duff Road, Penn Hills, PA 15235, to consider the proposed substantial change to the FY 2018 CDBG Annual Action Plan. All interested persons, groups, and organizations are encouraged to attend this public hearing and will be given the opportunity to present oral or written testimony concerning the proposed amendment for the FY 2018 Annual Action Plan.

The Council Chambers are accessible to persons with physical disabilities.
