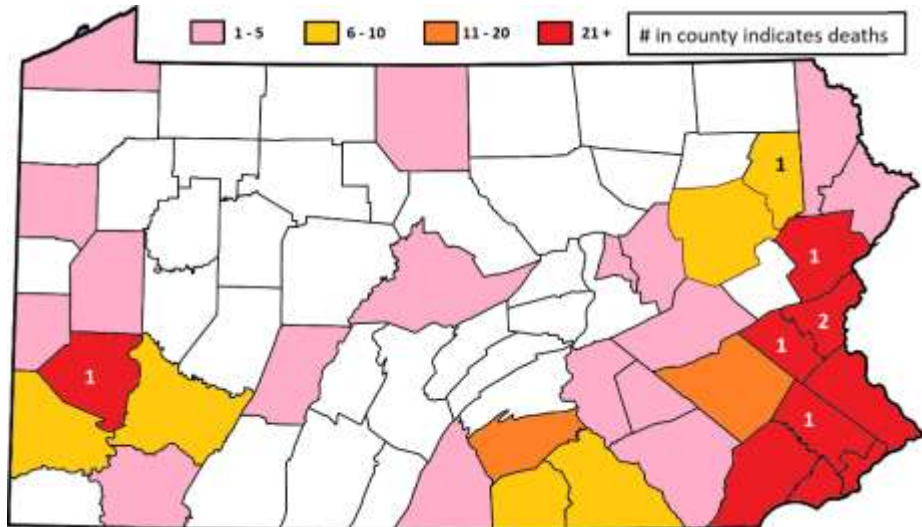

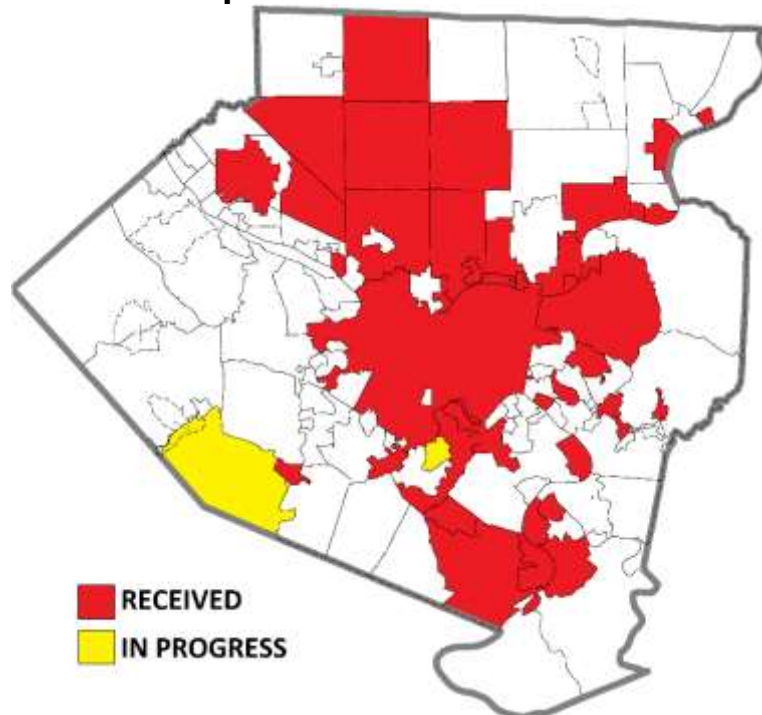
Pennsylvania COVID-19 Cases by County

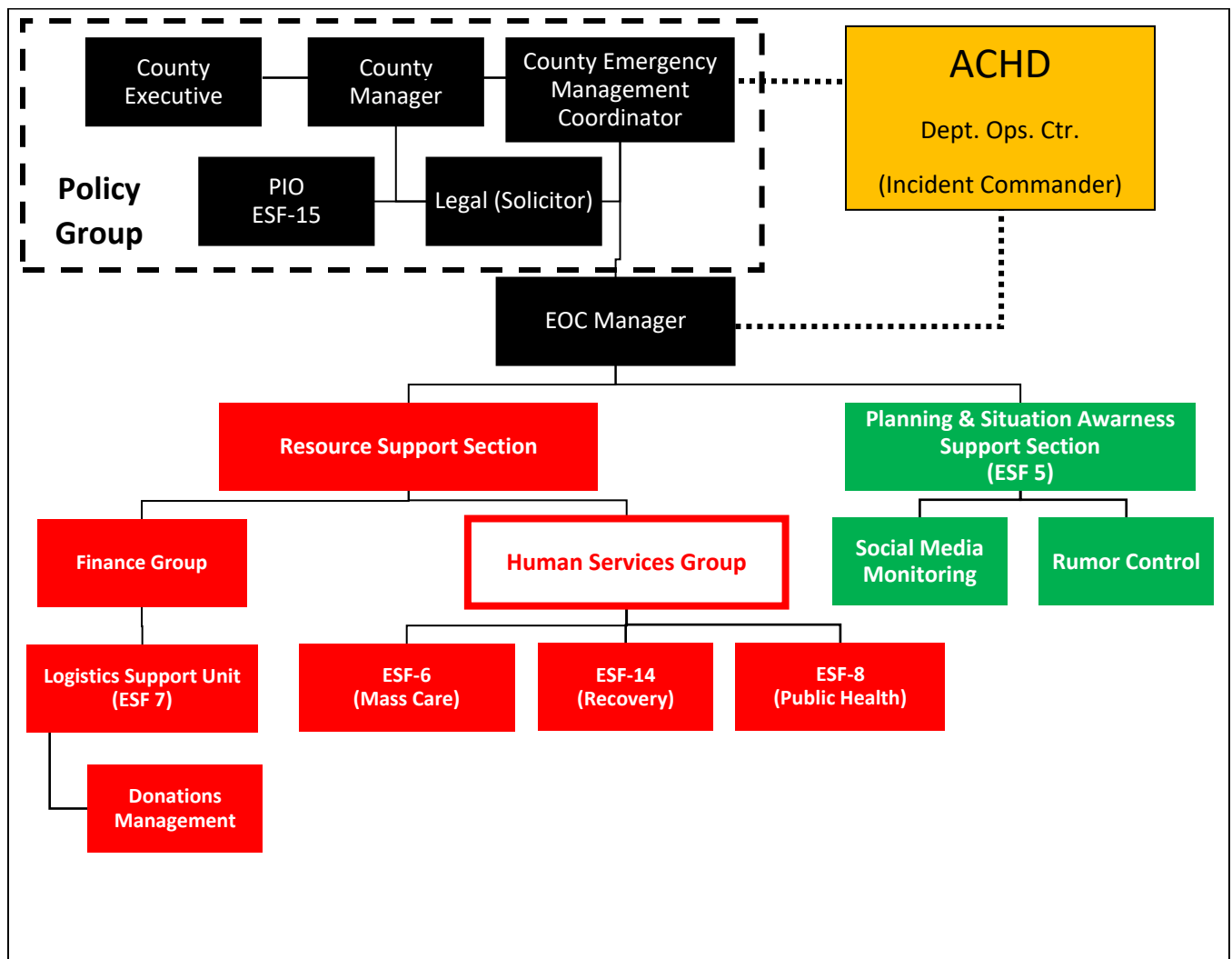

CURRENT SITUATION

As of March 11, 2020, WHO has declared the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) a pandemic.

The Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) has developed a strategic framework, outlined in the Pandemic Influenza Response Appendix for ACHD and support partners responding to, and sustaining functionality during a health emergency such as the COVID-19. The ACHD has activated its Departmental Operations Center (DOC) to monitor the emergence of the disease and to coordinate public health and medical aspects of the response.

- On March 13, 2020 the United States declared a national emergency.
- On March 19, 2020 Governor Wolf has ordered all “non-life sustaining businesses” in PA to physically close at 20:00 (8 pm) on March 19th.

- Community spread has occurred in Allegheny County, but not yet declared “sustained.”
- The American Red Cross faces blood shortage; 2,700 blood drives canceled due to concerns about coronavirus outbreak.
- On March 19th, the PA Department of Health confirmed the first COVID-19 related death in Pennsylvania (Northampton County).
- On March 21st Allegheny County confirmed its first COVID-19 related death. The second in Pennsylvania.
- On March 23rd the Governor places a Stay at Home Order on Allegheny County.

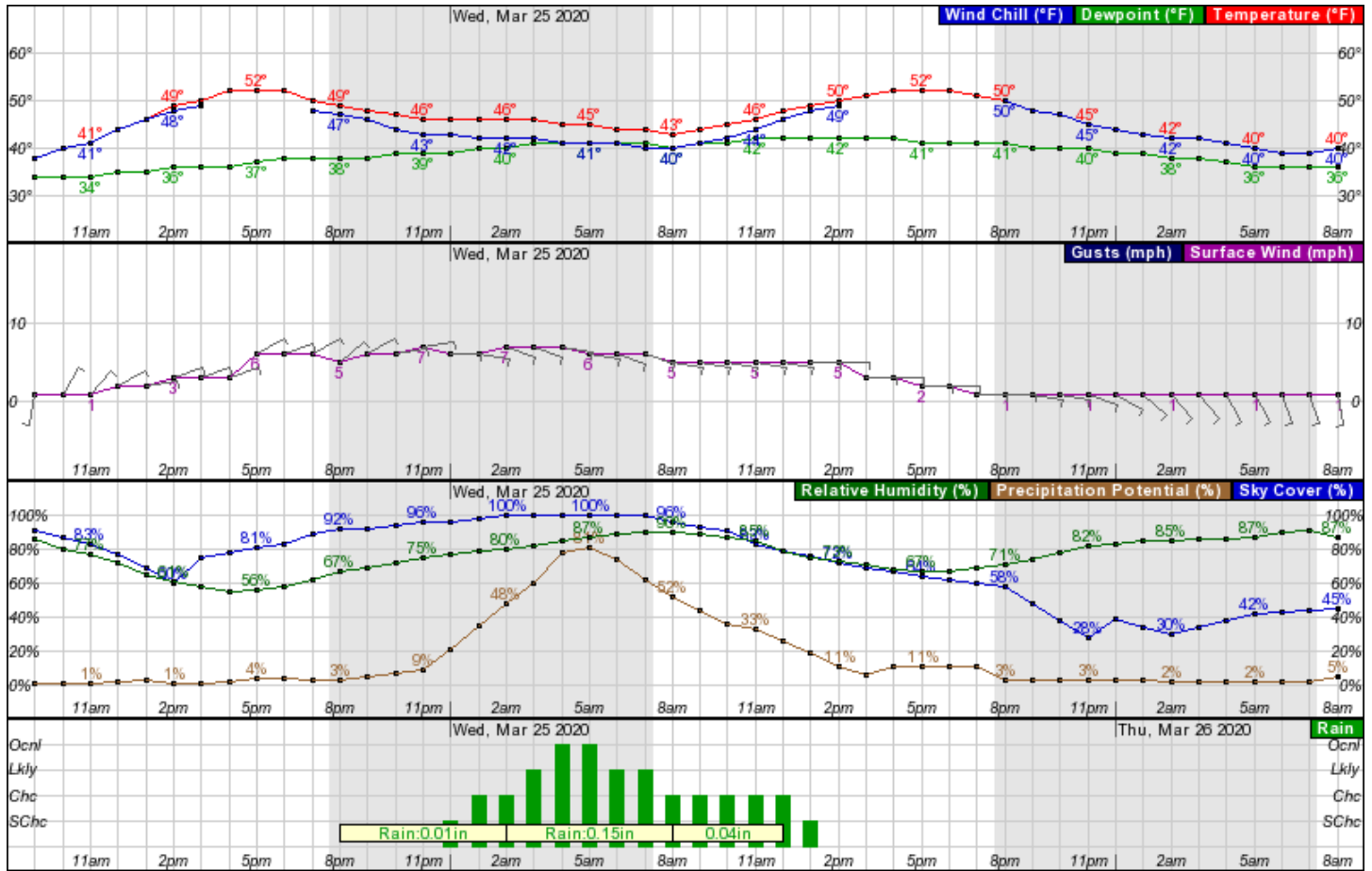

ACCOMPLISHMENTS (past 24 hours):

Allegheny County Health Department:

- ACHD has resumed specimen collection for cases under investigation.
- ACHD case update status: Total of 48 today. Six individuals are hospitalized with the remainder in self-isolation at home.
- Staffing adjustments continue to be made to meet operational needs.
- Contact tracing for the confirmed cases continues

Allegheny County Emergency Services:

- Maintaining Social Distancing via Virtual EOC activation via Microsoft teams.
- Sharing Resource distribution in daily SitReps
- Adding Volunteer and Donations Management under ESF:14
- All EMS callers will now be receiving COVID-19 screening questions.
- Created Regional EMS Working Group for planning.
- PA survey has been sent out.
- ACES Facility in Moon has been sanitized.

Allegheny County Human Services:

- Continued posting messages and resource links to social media for public engagement
- Posted food distribution map to help identify food donation sites

CHALLENGES:

Allegheny County Health Department:

- Some bumps in the road have been encountered with staffing reassignments and will be corrected to provide more clarity.
- ACHD working on a method to share information regarding cases with responders, yet to be finalized.

Allegheny County Emergency Services:

- Ongoing need for supplies, particularly cleaning supplies and masks/gloves for home visits.
- Providers starting to have staffing concerns, as many who rely on a lot of volunteers not currently getting that help.

Allegheny County Human Services:

- Ongoing need for supplies, particularly cleaning supplies and masks/gloves for home visits
- Provider need for diapers/baby supplies

PLANNED ACTIVITIES (next 24 to 72 hours):

Allegheny County Health Department:

- Share information on hospital sample collection for the public on our web page.
- Staff Virtual EOC with an ACHD representative.
- Develop enforcement strategy for environmental health programs, especially for food facilities, in light of the Governor's order.

- Evaluate options for additional specimen collection opportunities.

Allegheny County Emergency Services:

- Continue to distribute supplies as available to public safety partners
- 911 Center Pandemic Planning to sustain critical operations

Allegheny County Human Services:

- Continued working with United Way, who is organizing volunteer mobilization
- Working with County to manage donations that come in
- Daily provider calls to discuss plans and assess needs
